Allowance/Requirements: One pair of skis/snowboard and one bag containing a pair of ski/board boots only

Cost: Two pieces - Ski/board boot bag and one pair of skis/snowboard are charged the applicable checked bag charge for the 1st or 2nd checked bag. When in excess, each item will be subject to the baggage charge for a single piece.

Maximum Size and Weight: Ski/board boot bag up to 50 lbs. and 62 inches; One pair of skis/snowboard up to 115 inches.

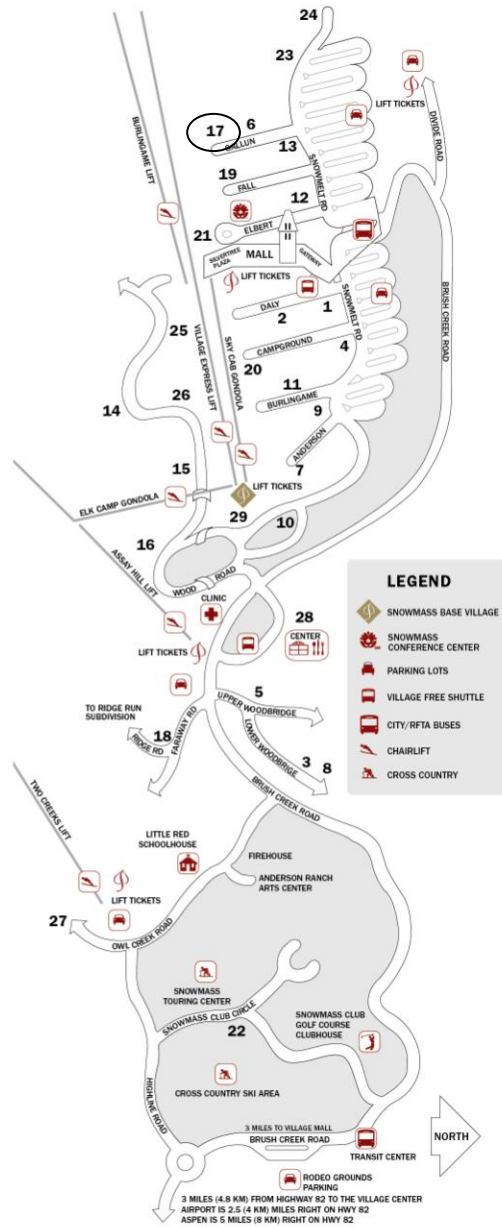

Frequently Asked Questions.....

1. Why is the trip itinerary Sunday to Saturday?

- This itinerary allows the Trip Participant a Saturday to get ready to go on the trip, and a Sunday to recover after returning to get ready to go back to work. The participant can still get 5 Full days of skiing in WITHOUT skiing on a Crowded Weekend day. Also a day less than a full week is cheaper for lodging costs.

2. Isn't Sunday the most expensive day to fly?

- I did a search on Travelocity +/- 3 days (Saturday to Monday) and there was no difference in price... Depends on when you look, as prices are always changing.

3. Why fly into Eagle County vs. Aspen/Pitkin County?

- The Aspen airport is relatively small and I was told is very susceptible to closure and delays caused by weather in the mountains. I did not want to risk a cancelled or delayed flight and/or connection. Aspen's runway can only handle small regional jets; Eagle County can handle larger jets and is not limited by as many weather related delays. Flights into and out of Eagle were cheaper than ASE which allowed us to get better lodging for the same package price. Eagle County is approximately 70 miles from Snowmass; we plan to have a private charter bus take us to/from the airport with a groceries/liquor stop on the way to the resort. Transportation and baggage handling and tips are included in the package price.

4. Why Stay at Snowmass vs. Aspen?

- There is a Lot more skiing at Snowmass than Aspen (3132 acres vs 673 acres), and at every level of ability. The skiing at Aspen is generally regarded as being very challenging. There is more affordable lodging available at Snowmass. The lift tickets are good at all four mountains and there are free shuttles between all Four Mountains; there is easy/convenient transportation between Snowmass and Aspen.

5. When Do I need to sign-up for the trip?

- The sooner the better. We have locked in Five 2BR/2BA and One 3BR/3BA "Premier Quality Units" at Interlude Condos. These units will go on a first come – first reserve basis. I will have to cancel any unreserved units by 1 September so that the Club does not risk losing the pre-paid lodging deposit. We may be able to get additional units at this same property or others near-by, but they will not be Premier Quality, may not be ski-In/Out, and may cost more.

6. What Does "Premier Quality Units" mean at Interlude Condos?

- The Condos are individually owned. Some are in better condition than others with newer and more standardized furnishings. The Management Company provides an assessment of each unit. Premier Vs Deluxe or Standard is similar to Gold Vs Silver or Bronze... (At least that is my understanding).
